Breeder was supplied a copy of disaster outline. The outline was discussed and breeder will comply.

Breeder keeps dogs in outside runs with Welded Wire fencing on concrete. Runs have roof, Tarps on back and sides. There are rollup tarps on front of runs for bad weather. Runs have Insulated Dog Houses, Lights, Heat and Heated Water. Music is played at runs. Dogs are exercised on a rotating basis in grass yard with parameter fencing. Puppies are whelped in large insulated dog houses with heat and heat lamps. In the winter litters are whelped in house. There was no odor and there were no sharp edges. Dogs all appeared healthy and were well socialized. Breeder is in compliance with AKC Care and Conditions Policy.
